Minimum Requirements for Advisor-led Programs

- ✓ Meet once weekly by zoom (or other online service) with student group for at least 45 minutes (starting by September)
- ✓ Have at least 10-12 enrolled students in group and at least 8-10 students per meeting
- ✓ Meet fall deadlines
 - MESA enrollment
 - Fall event registrations
 - MESA Day Student folder with:
 - MESA Day project selection and material list
 - MESA Day brainstorm
 - MESA Day progress photo
- ✓ Attend online monthly MESA meeting and online trainings
- ✓ Schedule August one-on-one with Rose or Elana

Support Provided by Pacific MESA

- ✓ Designated Pacific liaison that will join your zoom meetings. Liaison activities could include but are not limited to:
 - Short project related presentations
 - Chat Q&A about MESA projects
 - Material delivery
 - Check and manage enrollment
 - Student academic assistance (connecting students to scholarship resources, tutoring programs, transcript and educational resources).
- ✓ Four Fall competitions (2 in person, 2 online). In person competitions will occur in parking lots at 3 strategic sites (likely Edison, Pacific and Cesar Chavez). Students will be able to drop by during given times over a period of several days to test out their projects.
 - Safe gear, snacks and prizes will be associated with each competition
- ✓ Material delivery for competitions and MESA day projects that is based on teacher preferences.
- ✓ Other online activities such as webinars, field trips, and internships as well as Expanding your Horizons, Pacific STEM Day (Juniors and Seniors) and 8th Grade Night (for 8th Graders and their parents).
- ✓ Optional MESA training from Pacific MESA and Statewide MESA
- ✓ Direct student communications and reminders through Remind and Instagram.
