DROP OFF:



You can navigate to https://goo.gl/maps/fX1U5gmGoe5KKcTV8 from google maps or use the map below. You can enter from Pacific Avenue. Drop-off will be in front of the tower at the Yellow Drop-Off Star. The event will be from 8:00am-3:00pm at CSU East Bay.

All Centers will be joined by CSU East Bay College Student Ambassadors who will help to navigate you through the day. Every person in attendance will have a specialized schedule that will be printed on the back of your name tag and will be provided beforehand to your Center's staff. 12:30pm to 1:45pm: Active Competitions, Mini-Competitions, Activities


2:00pm to 2:45pm: Closing Ceremony/Awards
