**DROP OFF:**

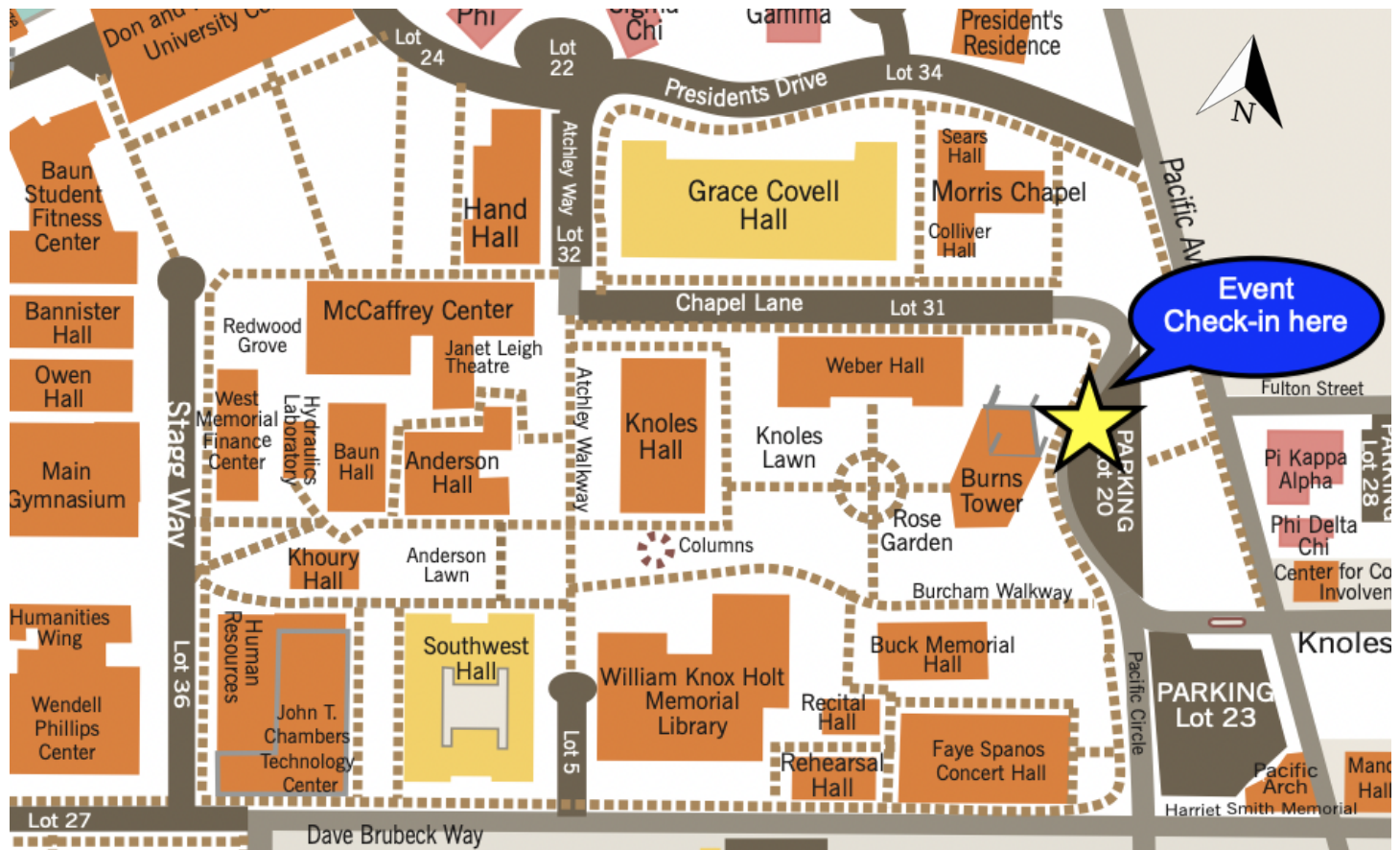

Below are the details about the event and what to expect at the 2023 Northern California Regionals.

We will welcome competing teams, advisors, and chaperones to our campus, starting at 7:30am, with breakfast and project check-in happening until 8:50am. Breakfast will be served in the hallways in front of the Gym. Note that no food or drink is allowed inside the Gym. A map of our campus has been included below that highlights where buses should be directed to drop-off and pick-up, as well as the location of the days' events.

All Centers will be joined by CSU East Bay College Student Ambassadors who will help to navigate you through the day. Every person in attendance will have a specialized schedule that will be printed on the back of your name tag and will be provided beforehand to your Center's staff. **9:20am to 12:00pm:** Active Competitions, Mini-Competitions, Activities


**11:30am to 1:00pm:** Lunch – Centers will be on a staggered schedule of 35 minutes to allow for social distancing in the Dining Commons

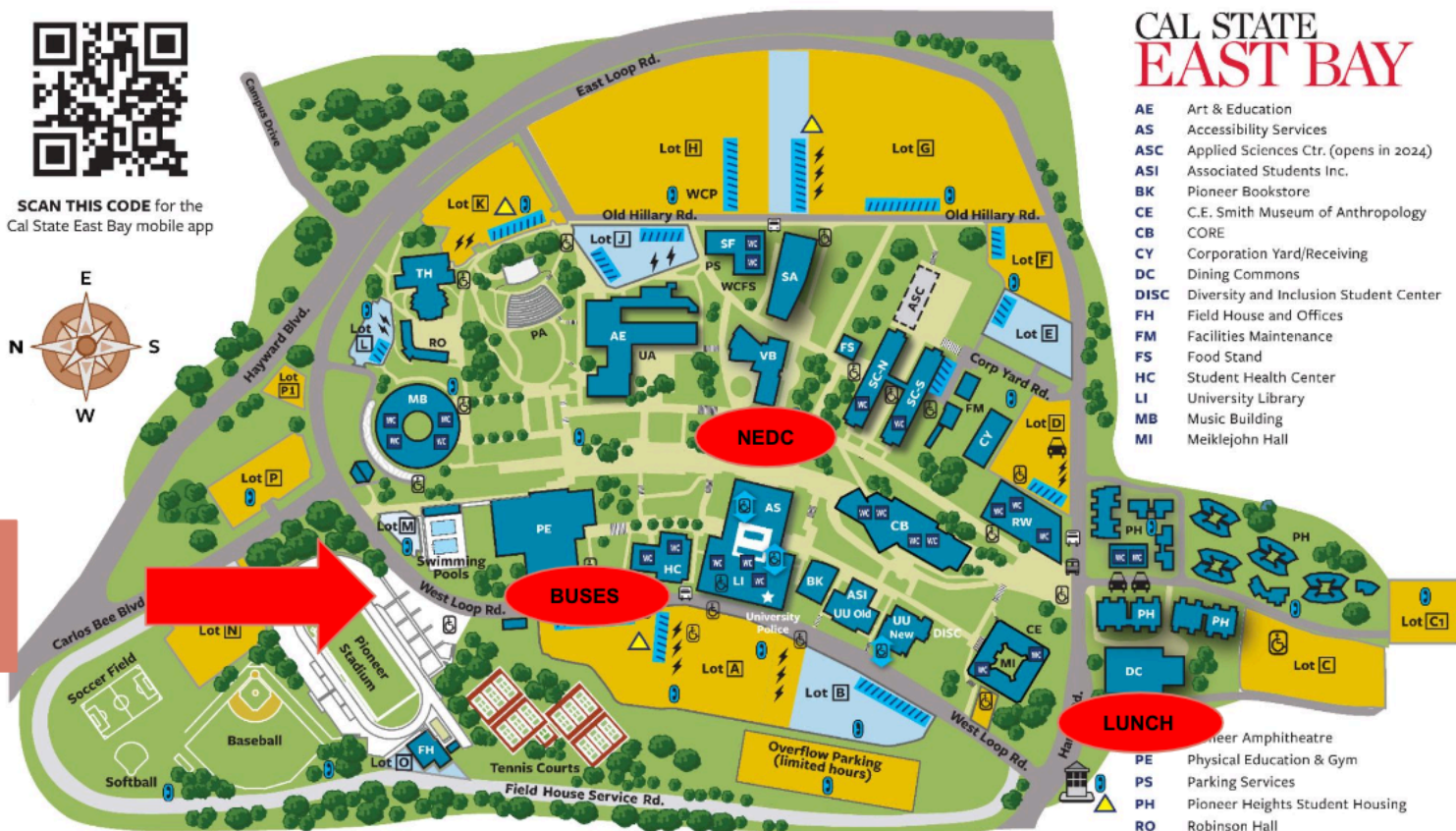
